When paired with the Brokk 70, the G32 can provide significant time and cost savings over manual methods for soft demolition applications in tight, confined spaces. The G32 grapple features a 12.8-inch (32.5-centimeter) jaw opening. One fixed and one movable jaw means the G32 can firmly grasp structural elements such as drywall, ceiling sections, piping and HVAC ducts, while a 360-degree hydraulic rotation circuit allows for fast and accurate positioning. Using the Brokk machine in these situations eliminates the need for harnessed workers on ladders or scaffolding manually cutting or pulling down structural elements.

Additionally, the precision and flexibility of the remote-controlled demolition machine with the grapple attachment makes it easy to pick up and sort even small debris. Boltable grip plates facilitate picking and sorting, allowing operators to complete those tasks without switching attachments.




The C25G models comply with all global emissions regulations, while delivering a high electrical efficiency up to 41.6% and 40.6% on pipeline natural gas, down to 71 and 68 methane number (MN) respectively at full power. In addition to its generator capabilities,

the innovative control systems fitted to the C25G series provide users with access to advanced monitoring, diagnostics, and predictive analytics, maximising the generators' uptime and reducing maintenance labour costs.

The greater fuel flexibility offered by the C25G series allows users to utilise a wide range of fuels, including pipeline natural gas down to 60 MN, and low BTU fuels, offering robust uninterruptible power at any time. In addition to the fuel flexibility, the C25G series can minimise the environmental impact with its cogeneration capabilities The NOX emissions are as low as 250 MN/Nm3, meeting global product-compliance requirements and certifications.

Cummins Zambia successfully commissions new coolant plant in Kitwe

Cummins Zambia has completed a coolant plant project in Kitwe on the Copperbelt that received approval from the Zambia Environmental Management Agency (ZEMA) in 2019. The 'plug-and-play' plant will produce two types of coolant, namely ES compleat Hybrid (Blue) and ES compleat OAT (Red). PLC-driven and automated, the plant has the capability to carry out batch correction. It has a blending capacity of around 1 600 litres over two hours, including quality testing. The system has two 2 500 litre product tanks for product storage.

Originally planned to be completed within six months in 2018, delivery and manufacturing logistics ultimately resulted in the project taking about a year to complete, in addition to the stringent ZEMA approval, John Kambing'a, Cummins Aftermarket Leader (Zambia) reports. The main contractor was CP Engineering, with a Cummins Filtration team overseeing the project from start to finish.


Cummins Filtration built the plant and shipped it to Zambia, where it was installed by a local

contractor under the supervision of the project team. The Cummins Filtration team from South Africa also played a key role in commissioning the plant.

"It is a requirement in Zambia to conduct an impact assessment for any project being undertaken. Therefore, the ZEMA approval was necessary to ensure that the coolant plant had no impact on the environment or the surrounding community," Kambing'a explains. This is also in line with Cummins Inc.'s PLANET 2050 strategy, focused on addressing climate change and air emissions, using natural resources in the most sustainable way, and improving communities.

To date, Cummins Zambia's main coolant customer has been First Quantum Minerals (FQM), a major copper producer in the region. The new plant will allow Cummins Zambia to supply coolant to other customers in different packages. "This will grow our filtration sales in Zambia, and allow us to serve other customers. It will also take care of our counter-sales customers. Other Cummins distributors and dealers wanting to take advantage of our cost-

Goodwood 7460 competitiveness will also be welcomed," Kambing'a highlights.

The main benefits of the new coolant plant are that customers will not be restricted to obtain the products only in totes, but can request different packages according to their specific requirements. Customers will also have the option of bulk supply, which will drastically reduce their storage challenges in having access to sufficient product as and when required, and eliminate long lead times. Switching to in-house coolant production at Cummins Zambia will reduce import costs significantly, allowing it to pass these savings onto customers.

Meshach Kwegyir-Aggrey, GM Cummins Zambia, elaborates that, in order to be more competitive and supply product at a preferential rate to the market, a business case was raised to the leadership team of Cummins Africa. Approval followed quickly, and the coolant plant was subsequently purchased and installed in the last quarter of 2019.

"With the new coolant plant at Cummins Zambia, what we have succeeded in doing is to basically halt the importation of water, which forms more than 90% of the coolant product, from South Africa into Zambia. This will also assist us to serve diverse markets, with volumes ranging from five litres to 1 000 litres. We will also increase our footprint in the Zambian coolant market and offer more value to customers."

Kwegyir-Aggrey adds: "The Zambian market is key to the strategic growth of Cummins in Africa. Cummins is a provider of power to the mining industry, and this new plant will allow us to deliver on our brand promise of powering our customers through innovation and dependability. We have invested almost half a million dollars in this project, and that will add value to our customers and stakeholders in Zambia. Adding value is what Cummins stands for, and we are determined to ensure our customers get absolute value when using Cummins products."

Looking to the future, Kwegyir-Aggrey points out that the new coolant plant will assist Cummins Zambia in penetrating the key automotive market. "It will help us leverage out other filtration products as a single package. Coolant is key in the operation of any machine, and the quality of the coolant matters. 



Five power supply considerations for businesses facing threatened energy security

As South Africans settle into the routine and inconvenience of load shedding and planning their activities around shifting electricity supply, it is businesses that are taking the biggest hit through the loss of operational capabilities, productivity, and profitability. While individuals deal with maneuvering their household times and sitting in gridlock traffic, local businesses, hospitals, schools, and industrial sites must find ways to remain operational despite limited generating capacity.

The electricity shortfall makes it crucial for organisations to reconsider their power supply systems. According to Nick Oosthuizen, Managing Director at Inframid and consultant in energy efficiency, there is no silver bullet to solving this challenge. "Businesses need to take a holistic approach when looking at securing their power supply. There is no one-size-fits-all solution. A tailored system, based on a feasibility study that considers unique power supply elements for your organisation, will ensure the highest return on investment (ROI)," he advises. According to Oosthuizen, there are at least five essential aspects to consider.

1.Know your load

To ensure an optimal energy supply system, you first need to understand what it is you are currently dealing with. It is important to know your electrical demand, load content, and architecture. "Businesses should conduct an electrical audit before considering other energy sources. This will help avoid fruitless expenditure and help plan a low energy load. A good place to start is by considering the energy efficiency of the load elements," says Oosthuizen.


"For instance, the Coefficient of performance (COP) is the efficiency of refrigeration, aircon, and water heating systems and is highly dependent on product quality. A higher COP equates to lower operating costs, so businesses should continuously consider the technology they are using, especially as part of maintenance replacement plans. The same considerations are relevant to light fitting technologies."

2.Check your utility connection "Although utility-supplied power is highly unreliable at the moment, it is still the cheapest. As your main source of energy, you should validate that you have utility connections at the most cost-effective tariff scale. Acquiring and operating backup power can be rather expensive if not part of an overall plan, and all energy-saving initiatives should be considered."

3.Consider your backup options
Popular backup power solutions include diesel generators, gas generators, and batteries. The chosen solution will largely depend on cost and usage requirements. "While backup power reduces your dependence on utility power – a feature in high demand at the moment – it comes at a price. Electrical teams need to motivate this investment to the decision-makers, and the best way to do this is through a financial feasibility study that weighs up all elements of power supply in relation to each other and the prevention of downtime," says Oosthuizen.

According to Oosthuizen, downtime can get very costly and should be measured when

looking at the feasibility of a backup power solution. This also bears weight on the kind of backup power you decide to use and when it will kick in. "This varies between industries and applications. For example, one minute of downtime before backup power kicks in might be too much for certain manufacturing plant." He advises that organisations should do a breakdown of electrical loads and establish the normal load, the backup load, and the essential load. The Essential load is where you can't lose a second and a seamless transfer will be needed.

4. Think about seamless transfer "For organisations who can't afford a lapse in power supply, a seamless transfer system will be necessary. However, this seamless transfer might not be needed for all loads in the facility. The essential load would be the priority, and would need an uninterruptible power supply (UPS) for mission-critical systems. However, being an expensive commodity, it is important to apply UPS to essential loads only and after determining its feasibility."

5.Save energy where you can
Reducing your energy requirements is an
obvious strategy when it comes to improving
your security of supply and reducing costs.
"When it comes to saving energy, it is not just
about the energy-efficiency of the technology
you use.

Supplementary power sources are something worth considering. Renewable energy generation in the form of solar, wind and other states of the art generation can be implemented. This has the potential to convert your load into a valuable asset," advises Oosthuizen.

He says: "One of the biggest mistakes we see is that organisations focus on the glaring symptoms of power cuts and try to heal these with specific power supply elements, without following a holistic approach. They overlook the bigger picture. Different industries have unique load structures serving specific operational needs, each needing different combinations of power supply elements. Each of these elements addresses a very specific area of energy efficiency, such as security of supply,

protecting essential loads, saving energy, and avoiding expensive upgrades."

"An independent energy procurement process should be conducted to provide appropriate and competitive solutions, where tender documentation based on international standards is sent out to various suppliers of different power supply-, seamless transfer- and renewable energy sources to tender. This process will also increase the overall feasibility."

Oosthuizen advises that a good energy strategy is to utilise utility power augmented by other feasible energy elements and to shift loads to minimise energy usage. "A good energy efficiency strategy is a worthwhile investment as it helps companies to avoid costly downtime and saves energy usage, thus improving the return on the investment made," concludes Oosthuizen.


